Where in the World Do I Live?



In Year 2 our new topic is 'Where in the World do I live?'. We will use our Geography skills to discover more about the four countries that make up the United Kingdom.

Design and Technology

Geography: Where in the World? - Name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas.

Maths:

- Count forwards and backwards in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens and ones).
- Compare and order numbers to 100.
- Read and write numbers to 100.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally.
- Solve a range of problems using these facts.

English: Writing journey stories and creating a fact file

- Understand what nouns, adjectives and verbs are and use them correctly in a journey story.
- Writing factual sentences to create a fact file about Cambridge.
- Whole class guided reading sessions.
- Handwriting - continuing to use the cursive style.
