

French:

Learning French vocabulary related to fruits.

PE:

The children will continue with cricket in outdoor PE and with dance indoors.

RE:

D&T:

The children will design and make their own Greek pitta sandwich.

Music:

The children will be singing and composing music.

Computing:

Using Purple Mash to learn about branching databases and graphing.

Maths:

Continue with their fluency for the 4 and start to learn the 8 times tables.
